Pollinator Garden Crew Member

Summary Description

CRC recently planted and opened a pollinator garden in downtown Seeley Lake! We need assistance keeping the garden maintained and thriving. This role entails general maintenance in the garden, special garden improvement projects, and welcoming the public into the garden during "open hours."

Duties/Responsibilities

Every shift:

- water plants
- closely monitor the health of the plants
- fill fountain with sufficient water
- restock pollinator feeders
- host "open hours" during your shift for the public to explore the garden

Occasional tasks:

- conduct pollinator surveys
- weeding
- preparation for pollinator garden events
- attend CRC staff meetings when available

We welcome your own ideas as well!

Time Commitment

2 hours per week (through the end of August)

Requirements

- some gardening experience is desirable but not required
- interest in learning more and/or educating on pollinators and the importance of pollination
- recurring weekly availability

Training/Supervision

A general garden training will be provided when you begin volunteering. This training will get you acquainted with the garden and your garden duties (e.g. watering, weeding).

Once trained, you will be supervised by Amanda Zelnis (CRC's watershed coordinator) and Ginger Williams (lead garden volunteer). Amanda will be your contact for all things administrative and scheduling. Ginger will be your contact for any garden specific questions.

Benefits

- learn about pollinators and the importance of pollinator gardens
- engage with interested community members
- research shows that gardening reduces stress levels
- work collaboratively with CRC and fellow garden crew to develop garden ideas
- watch your hard work grow!
